Qualified nominees will be notified by the Registrar following the close of nominations and prior to the Campaign period. If at the close of the nomination period there is only one candidate per seat available, the nominated candidate will be declared elected.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD | August 21-25, 2023 ELECTION DAY | August 28, 2023 (9am to 4pm)

The first Board of Governors meeting following the election will be October 13, 2023.

#### FLIGIBITY

In order to be a candidate or nominator, a support staff member must be:

- employed by Coast Mountain College as support staff as of the notice of election date, and;
- a dues paying member of the BCGEU Support Staff Bargaining unit, or;
- on leave which allows accrual of seniority.

## **NOMINATION**

All Nominees are required to submit a typed candidate statement, no longer than 250 words in length, along with their completed nomination form.

Nomination forms are available through a Campus Administration Officer, Registration offices, or see any BCGEU representative.
