## DISPLAY OF FLAGS POLICY

#### 1.00 PURPOSE

1.1 Coast Mountain College (CMTN) displays flags with dignity, respect, and generally established etiquette.

#### 2.00 DEFINITIONS

2.1 **Half-masting:** Flags are flown at the half-mast position as a sign of respect and mourning for an individual of precedence<sup>1</sup> or on special days that are federally and/or provincially designated to be commemorated.

#### 3.00 POLICY SCOPE

3.1 This policy applies to all CMTN campuses and centres where the national, provincial or CMTN flags are displayed.

#### 4.00 RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 The Facilities Director and Facilities staff are responsible for monitoring the condition, requesting the replacement, and disposing of flags.

### 5.00 DISPLAY ETIQUETTE

- 5.1 Flags are displayed on exterior flagpoles at CMTN campuses and centres.
- 5.2 Flags will be flown at half-mast in commemoration of federally and provincially designated days and as a sign of mourning upon the death of those listed in *Display of Flags Procedure*.
