

INFORMATION FOR IMMUNIZATION & IMMUNE STATUS FOR HEALTH PROGRAM STUDENTS

In accordance with provincial legislation and policy, all individuals working in clinical learning situations within Northern Health and other provincial health authorities must meet certain medical requirements. This information is to be gathered in advance of commencing clinical placements, and will reside with your educational institutions where it can be retrieved and shared with the health authorities if required.

This immunization record should not be considered a list of eligibility as one may qualify for or require additional vaccines based on personal risk factors or age.

Students are strongly recommended to receive their immunizations with a health care provider PRIOR to starting the program. Failure to do so may result in the student being barred from practice in the clinical setting based on health authority policies.

In addition, should there be an outbreak of any of the communicable diseases for which immunization is recommended by the Program, any student who is not immunized <u>will be barred</u> from the clinical setting for the duration of the outbreak.

Students are responsible for ongoing immunization and health screening as recommended by Northern Health guidelines, and providing this updated information to their educational institution.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ANNUAL SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINE IS REQUIRED (OR MASK MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES IN PATIENT CARE AREAS FOR DURATION OF INFLUENZA SEASON). STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PROOF OF INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION ANNUALLY.
